### Taiwan's Presidential Election

1	The year 2024 will be marked by as many as 40 ①national elections, starting with Taiwan's		
pre	esidential election in January, and running through the US presidential election in November.		
Blo	comberg Economics estimates that 3.2 billion voters, representing 41% of the world's population and		
429	% of its GDP, have a chance to elect new leaders. Some of them, such as the presidential elections in		
the U.S, Russia and Taiwan, could determine future geopolitical trends and shape relationships among			
lea	ding global powers.		

The first election this year will be held in Taiwan on January 13<sup>th</sup>. It is considered crucial for the direction of the world. ①The status of Taiwan has always been a complicated political issue. China currently claims Taiwan is a part of the People's Republic of China. China's President Xi Jinping(習近平) has frequently stated that "reunification" with Taiwan must be fulfilled, and has indicated the possible use of force to achieve ②this. (③), the current Taiwan president Tsai Ing-wen(蔡英文) has claimed that Taiwan is already an independent country, and does not have to push for any sort of formal independence.

At Taiwan's National Day celebrations on October 10<sup>th</sup>, Tsai Ing-wen said it was her duty to protect the freedoms and way of life of Taiwan's people. "In the midst of tremendous internal and external pressures, Taiwan's democracy has grown and thrived. The Taiwanese people will be a democratic and free people for generations to come," she said.



4 <u>Three candidates</u> have run for Taiwanese President. The current Vice President Lai Ching-te(頼 清徳) has had a lead in the poll. He says; "China and Taiwan are different." He criticized both of his rivals for supporting what Beijing calls the one-China principle. According to some estimates, if the course of independence is confirmed in the presidential election, another war could break out. If the opposition wins, tensions between Taiwan and China could temporarily decrease.

## Russian Presidential Election

- The system of governments can be divided into three categories: democratic, authoritarian, and hybrid. 2 Democratic countries aim at protecting citizens' rights, and enable them to make laws and elect their leaders in free and transparent elections. On the other hand, authoritarian nations enact laws without the approval of the citizens. Religious freedom and the freedom of speech are restricted in authoritarian regimes.
- There is another form of government: "Hybrid regime". Hybrid regimes are categorized as having a combination of authoritarian features with democratic ones. They hold elections and political repressions simultaneously. For example, Russia has a multi-party system, but actually operates as a one-party system.
- 4 Vladimir Putin will run in the March 17th presidential election, in which he is all but certain to win. He will prolong his repressive and unyielding grip on Russia for at least another six years.
- "The level of democracy is <u>Odeteriorating</u>. 72% of the world's population, 5.7 billion people, live under authoritarian rule", said the V-Dem Institute, a Swedish organization that studies the qualities of "The democratic decline has been most dramatic between 2002 and 2022. The number of countries in the world that are currently experiencing autocratization has greatly increased over the past ten years – from 13 to 42 countries. 28% of the world's population now live in closed autocracies compared to 13%, 1 billion people, who live in liberal democracies."

#### U.S. Presidential Election

- 1 The U.S. presidential election will be on 5<sup>th</sup> November. The winner will serve a term of four years in the White House starting in January 2025.
- 2 Joe Biden is expected to be the Democratic Party nominee, and despite legal troubles, Donald Trump is the current front-runner for the Republicans. There are also some independent candidates, including Robert F. Kennedy Jr, nephew of former president John F. Kennedy.
- On December 9<sup>th</sup>, Wall Street Journal poll says Biden lags behind Trump by 4%, 47% to 43%, on a hypothetical presidential rematch. On the other hand, some say ①abortion is a winning issue for Democrats. In June 2022, the U.S. Supreme Court officially declared that the constitutional right to abortion no longer exists. Now, nearly two dozen U.S. states have banned or limited access to abortion.
- 4 Abortion rights are the dominant issue in American politics. Donald Trump opposes legal abortion. In 2016 presidential election, he said, "Women should face punishment for having abortions." Meanwhile, Biden says, "I believe that a woman's right to choose abortion is fundamental.


