Biden-Kishida summit aims for stronger US-Japan security ties

- Prime Minister Fumio Kishida made an official visit to the U.S. in the beginning of April. On April 10th, he and President Joe Biden held a summit where they discussed as many as 70 cooperation agreements in ①the Oval Office.
- Amid ②an increasingly severe international situation, including repeated attacks on Philippine vessels by Chinese coast guard ships in South China Sea, and nuclear and missiles development in North Korea, Kishida and Biden agreed to improve cooperation between the Japanese Self-Defense Forces and the US forces in Japan. It is the most significant upgrade in military ties since the alliance between the two countries began.
- The U.S. maintains troops on every continent. As of 2022, there are more than 170,000 active-duty military troops across 178 countries, with the most in Japan (54,000), Germany (36,000), and South Korea (25,000). The U.S. Seventh Fleet is based in Yokosuka(Kanagawa), the Third Marine Expeditionary Force is based on Okinawa, and 130 U.S. Air Force fighters are stationed at Misawa Air Base(Aomori) and Kadena Air Base(Okinawa).
- Both leaders underscored the importance to continue a dialogue with China, and cooperate with China. They also reiterated the importance of ③peace and stability across the Taiwan Strait.
- On April 11th, Biden hosted a trilateral summit with Kishida and the Philippines President Ferdinand Marcos Jr, aiming to send China a clear message that it must halt its aggressive behavior in the South China Sea. "I want to be clear, the United States' defense commitments to Japan and to the Philippines are ironclad," Biden said.

Japanese astronauts to land on the Moon under Artemis Program

- 1 At the summit meeting, Kishida and Biden agreed to enhance relations in not only international security but also AI and space projects, including the US-led Artemis lunar exploration program.
- Biden said in a press conference, "Two Japanese astronauts will join the future Artemis mission, and one will become the first non-American to land on the Moon."
- 3 "It's the next chapter in the cosmic partnership between our two nations," NASA Administrator Bill Nelson said at a press conference. "America will no longer walk on the Moon alone. We are going and we are very proud to go with Japan."
- [4] Two American astronauts are expected to land on the Moon in 2026 in Artemis III, the first U.S. Moonlanding mission since the end of the Apollo program, in which 12 astronauts, all U.S. citizens and white males, landed on the Moon between 1969 and 1972. According to the Japan-U.S. agreement, a Japanese astronaut will set foot on the Moon and explore the lunar surface in 2028 in Artemis IV.
- Japan, in return, will contribute to the Artemis missions by providing a pressurized lunar rover, which JAXA has been trying to develop with Toyota Motor Corporation. The rover will make it possible for astronauts to drive on the Moon without wearing spacesuits.
- 6 NASA intends to land the first woman and first person of color on the Moon. Artemis is the twin sister of Apollo and goddess of the Moon in Greek mythology.

The new space race

- Six decades after the Soviet Union and the U.S. raced each other to get to the Moon, a new competition has emerged. This time, ①more countries are competing with each other.
- 2 China says its manned lunar mission would take place by 2030 as it aims to become the second country to land astronauts on the Moon. On March 20th, China launched 2Queqiao-2, which will be used as a communications bridge between the earth and upcoming lunar probe missions on the far side of the Moon until 2030.
- China has an ambition to build its status as a major space power. China landed the Chang'e-3 spacecraft in 2013, becoming the first nation to soft-land on the lunar surface after the U.S. and the Soviet Union. In 2019, it became the first country to land a spacecraft on the Moon's far side.
- 4 Russia launched its first Moon-landing spacecraft in 47 years in August 2023 and failed. India's Chandrayaan-3 spacecraft successfully landed on the Moon in the same month. The U.S. meanwhile, is rushing to be the first country to land astronauts on the Moon after the Apollo program.
- 5 Lunar exploration is important in three aspects. First, it will lead to scientific discoveries about Earth's origin and early history. Additionally, it opens up possibilities for business ventures and technological innovations. Oxygen, helium-3 and several metals are abundant on the Moon. It is important to find ways to develop these resources.
- [6] Third, for a preparation to live on Mars. Mars is one of the planets where life may have existed in the solar system, and the Moon can serve as a stepping stone to Mars. You can get back to Earth from the Moon quickly in only three days, while it takes 7 months to get back from Mars to Earth.
