Princess Kako visits Brazil

- Princess Kako visited Brazil for two weeks, from June 4 to 18, 2025. This was her fourth official visit to a foreign country after visiting Austria, Peru, and Greece. She visited Brazil for two main reasons: to promote friendship between the two countries, and to meet Japanese-Brazilians living there.
- 2 Before the trip, Princess Kako went to a museum in Kobe called the "Overseas Migration and Cultural Interaction Center.*" She studied the history of Japanese people who moved to Brazil.

- A long time ago in Meiji era, many Japanese moved to Brazil to work on coffee farms. Later, some of them became independent farmers or started small businesses. Today, about two million Japanese-Brazilians live in Brazil. The country has the largest Japanese community outside Japan.
- 4 During her visit, Princess Kako met President Lula in Brasilia, the capital city. She also visited several local elementary schools and homes for elderly Japanese Brazilians.
- 5 She also visited Corcovado Hills. It is well-known for the big statue of Jesus Christ. It looks over the city of Rio de Janeiro. She also visited Iguazu Falls, one of the most famous waterfalls in the world.
- 6 At a special event to celebrate the 130th anniversary of friendship between Japan and Brazil, she said in her speech, "Brazil is far away, on the other side of Japan, but I feel our hearts are very close. I hope our two countries will stay close amigos."
